

## TOUR CUSCO & MACHU PICHU 04 DAYS/03 NIGHTS



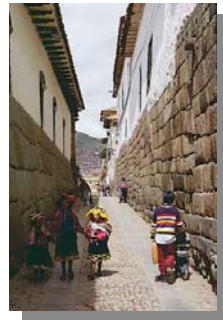
### Itinerary

#### Day 01 LIMA / CUSCO

Arrival to Cusco, reception, assistance and transfer to the hotel. Visitors should take a short rest in order to adjust to the altitude.

Afternoon tour to the city visiting the Koricancha Temple and the Cathedral. Continue to the surrounding ruins: the fortress of Sacsayhuaman overlooking the city, Kenko, Pucapucara and the Tambomachay Ruins.

#### Day 02 CUSCO / MACHU PICCHU / CUSCO

Catch the morning train for a full day tour of **Machu Picchu**, you will travel by Expedition train to the "Lost City of the Incas" being one of the most renowned examples of Inca architecture.

Surrounded by lush cloud forest, the citadel perches on a mist-shrouded mountain top. Lunch at local restaurant.

Back to Cusco by train .

**Full Day Sacred Valley of the Incas:** The Colonial town of Pisac, you can buy some souvenirs in the "Indio Market". Visit Urubamba to enjoy a **buffet lunch** with typical food



After lunch, continue to **Ollantaytambo**, the oldest continuously occupied settlement in the Americas. Ollantaytambo's narrow streets, complete with canals unchanged since Inca times, recall its ancient.

Return to Cusco, by the way of Chincheros, lies on the foundations of an important Inca site built in late 1400s. Brightly dressed, the people of Chinchero gather in the main plaza to barter foodstuffs and offer visitors an array of crafts from the Cusco region against a scenery of breathtaking beauty.

Located just ten minutes from the airport and the most important monuments and ruins of Cusco, two blocks from the Cathedral and the Plaza de Armas.

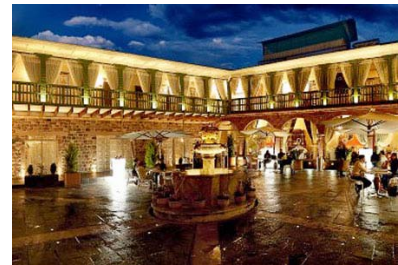


The hotel has 123 rooms. Construction is original seventeenth century and has been restored and converted into a luxury 5 stars hotel.

**1.- Casa Andina Cusco Catedral**

About as close as you can get to Cusco's Cathedral & beautiful Plaza de Armas without actually being on the busy square.
